

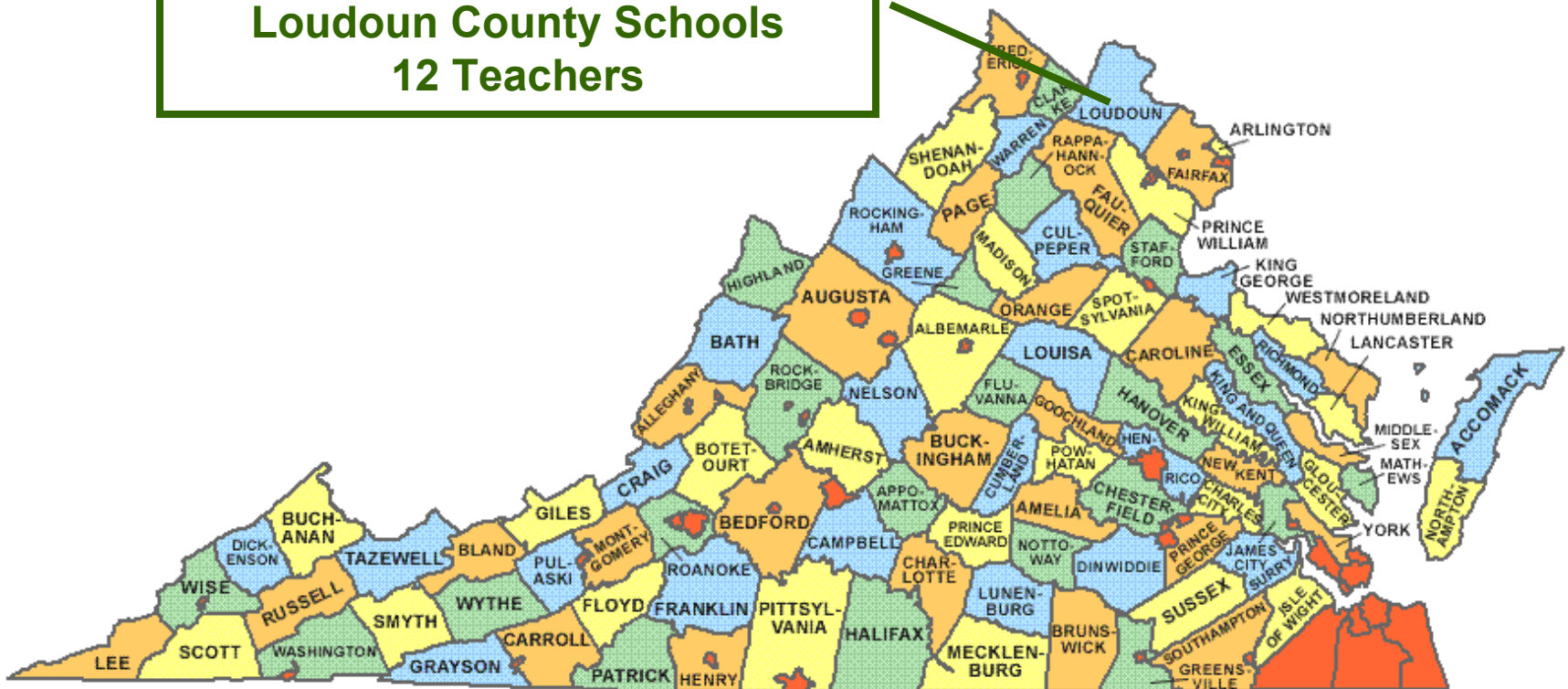

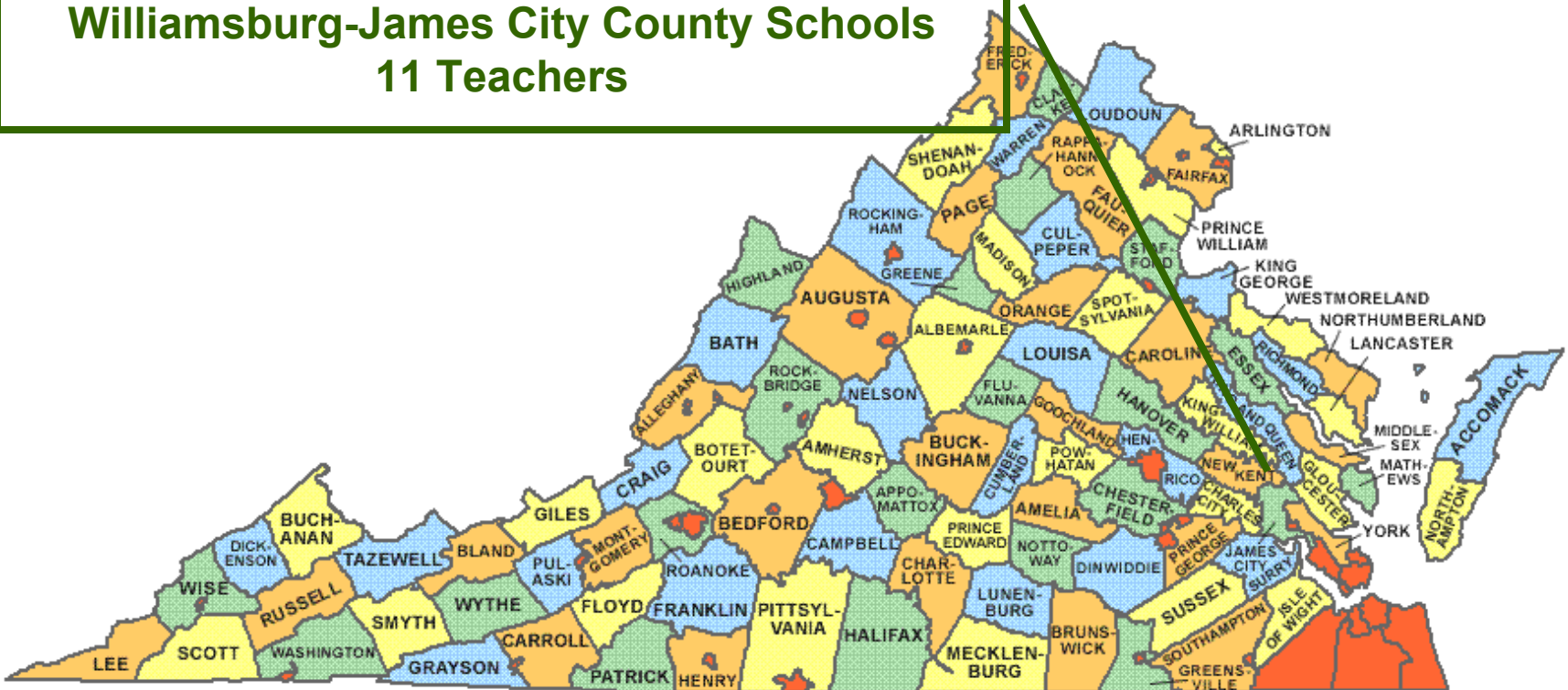

- To increase students' critical thinking skills by
 - reviewing 2008 survey data
 - reviewing cognitive demand for each standard of learning
 - providing teaching strategies that support Sheltered Instruction Observation Protocol (SIOP) instructional model

Middle School Timeframe

- Session 1: February
 - Review 2008 survey data
 - Preview and complete Instructional Practices portion of 2009 survey
- Session 2: May/June
 - Train on cognitive demand
 - Complete Instructional Content portion of 2009 survey
- Session 3: August/September
 - Review 2009 survey data
